## **Church visit on Saturday Morning**



This would not normally be on the itinerary of Laurel and Hardy Conventions, but there is good reason that we will be visiting the fifteenth century St James Church, Whitefriars. It is the home of Norwich Puppet Theatre. The church was closed as a place of worship and used as a homeless shelter. In

1980 following internal conversion, it re-opened the was as puppet theatre. lt has а 175 seat 50 auditorium. seat studio. а workshops, gallery space, a shop and bar. There are regular puppet workshops. shows and lt equipped to show films on a large screen. The theatre creates some of their puppets on site. They present shows throughout the UK and abroad.



Interestingly, the venue is now linked with one of its original uses, as it is licensed for Weddings and civil partnerships.



It is a fascinating place to visit and learn about the world of puppetry. Paul and I went there a couple of weeks ago and we know that they are really looking forward to presenting their private puppet show for the Sons of the Desert
