In the last Update, I printed a Check List. I thought I would repeat myself, repeat myself, repeat myself...too much cucumber!


- Tent Banners We will display them in the Ballroom. We will not have a Parade as such, but a 'Welcome Sons' greeting on the first night.


### THE CONVENTION UPDATES
