We will be based at Mercure Hotel, Norwich. The hotel has a swimming pool, gymnasium, ample free parking and large function rooms. What type of rooms are now available?

Twin and double rooms are available. There are also some triple rooms, where the third bed is a sofa bed. We were initially allocated four rooms for single occupancy (these are twin or double rooms) and have been able to increase this number to twelve. There is a single room supplement for these but all twelve rooms were snapped up very quickly. If you are willing to share but don't know anyone to share with, we will keep a list and advise so that we can find someone suitable of your choice.

The Mercure Hotel, Norwich

Gemma and Gill at the hotel have been very helpful to us and are really looking forward to The Sons of the Desert event. The hotel is a medium to large hotel with excellent facilities with three different sized function rooms. We will at different times be using all the function rooms. There is ample FREE parking. It is located on a ring road about two miles from the city centre. There is a regular bus service to and from the city centre with a stop nearby.
